



PROCEEDINGS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DERIDDER, STATE OF LOUISIANA, TAKEN IN REGULAR SESSION HELD ON MONDAY, FEBRUARY 10, 2020.

The Council of the City of DeRidder, Louisiana met in Regular Session at its meeting place, the Council Chambers, located at City Hall, 200 South Jefferson Street, DeRidder, Louisiana on Monday, February 10, 2020 at 5:30 o'clock p.m. President Keith Hooper called the meeting to order, Councilwoman Lydia Reynolds led the Invocation and Councilman Gordon Jenkins led the Pledge of Allegiance. The roll was called by the Clerk as follows: Councilman Gordon Jenkins; Councilwoman Kimaron Moore; Councilman Julian Williams; Councilwoman Lydia Reynolds; Councilman Vincent Labue and President Keith Hooper. Councilman Randy Larken was absent. Also present were Misty Clanton, Mayor; David Lestage, City Attorney; and Glenna Luther, Clerk of the Council.

Visitors' Docket. President Hooper announced that the Visitors' Docket is set aside for anyone who wished to come forward and speak on an item not on the Agenda. Charlie Bordelon addressed the Council concerning his volunteer work geotagging graves within Beauregard, Community, Starlight and Woodlawn Cemeteries. Jerrie Ledoux, Community Liaison for Congressman Mike Johnson, addressed the Council concerning the importance of Community participation in the 2020 Census. Dale Saffold came forward and questioned the Council about the appearance of the Sawmill House. President Hooper informed Ms. Saffold that the appearance of the Sawmill House is due to improvements being made to the structure. She then addressed the Council about her plans for Black History Month and announced that the NAACP Annual Program will be held on February 29, 2020 at New Hope CME Church and invited everyone to attend.

Adoption of Minutes. President Hooper stated the minutes of the previous regular meeting have been distributed and there being no corrections voiced by the Council, the January 27, 2020 minutes were unanimously approved by the Council.

President Hooper announced there were no service awards, bid awards, ratifications, condemnations resolutions, or Introduction of Ordinances and moved to the next item on the Agenda as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. O-2020-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 15, ARTICLE VII, SECTION 15-188 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO ZONING APPLICATION FEES, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the regulations for Zoning Application Fees within the City of DeRidder, Louisiana ("City") is provided for in Chapter 15 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of DeRidder, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of DeRidder, Louisiana ("City") and the Mayor recognize there is a need to establish fees pertaining to zoning within the corporate limits of City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of DeRidder that Chapter 15, Article VII, Section 15-188 be amended as follows:

Section 15-188: Application fees.


The following application and inspection fee schedule shall be paid upon application to the Public Works Director for approval of an applicant's request under this chapter:

Filing of Petition for Annexation	\$500.00
Planning Approval Request.....	\$250.00
Rezoning Request.....	\$250.00
Zoning Map	\$25.00
Special Exception Use.....	\$250.00
Variance Request	\$250.00
Mobile Home Park Review (each review)	\$50.00
Subdivision Review (each review).....	\$50.00
Dedication Request	\$50.00
Re-Subdivision.....	\$50.00




BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same are hereby, repealed.
