A. **Introductions.**

1. AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF DERIDDER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LANDMARK AMERICAN INSURANCE COMPANY THROUGH MCGRIFF INSURANCE SERVICES, INC. FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING A PACKAGE OF COMMERCIAL PROPERTY INSURANCE FOR THE 1ST STREET SCHOOL, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.
2. FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING THE ROOF AND MAKING REPAIRS TO THE INSIDE OF THE BEAUREGARD MUSEUM RESULTING FROM DAMAGES CAUSED BY HURRICANE LAURA, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF DERIDDER TO ENTER INTO AN ACT OF PREDIAL SERVITUDE WITH JAMES CLAYTON CHAMBLEE, II & DEANNA CHAMBLEE FOR DRAINAGE IN, ON AND UNDER THE IMMOVABLE PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN THE BODY OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.
