A. **Introductions.**
  1. AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF DERIDDER THROUGH ITS MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CIVILIAN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY, NAVAL SURFACE WARFARE CENTER, CRANE DIVISION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF LEASING NIGHT VISION EQUIPMENT, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

2. AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF DERIDDER, THROUGH ITS MAYOR, TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH R. C. PAVING, INC. AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPROVING A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DERIDDER AND WAYNE HALL CONSTRUCTION FOR REPAIRS TO THE FAÇADE, INCLUDING PAINTING, OF THE REAL ART DERIDDER BUILDING, A PUBLIC BUILDING OWNED BY THE CITY OF DERIDDER, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.
7. AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE APPROVING A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DERIDDER AND INLAND ENVIRONMENTS LTD. FOR REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF FLOORING AND LEAD PAINT CONTAINING ASBESTOS FROM THE DANCE STOP BUILDING, A PUBLIC BUILDING OWNED BY THE CITY OF DERIDDER, RESULTING FROM DAMAGES CAUSED BY HURRICANE LAURA, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.
8. AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF DERIDDER THROUGH ITS MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PAT WILLIAMS CONSTRUCTION, L.L.C. FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING THE ROOF AND MAKING REPAIRS TO THE INSIDE OF THE BEAUREGARD MUSEUM RESULTING FROM DAMAGES CAUSED BY HURRICANE LAURA, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.
